



Reminder: During the Fire Walk all Big Braves and Princesses are to observe silence and reflect on their time as father and daughter. Please, no flashlights, only torches. Please walk into and sit quietly in the Sacred Circle, respecting each other and the Great Spirit.

A few items to remember:

- **Friday Night Tacos and a Movie** – The Nation Chiefs will be cooking up a tasty Mexican feast. This will be make-your-own tacos and tortilla chips. Remember to bring your own drinks and maybe a comfortable chair and or blanket to sit on to watch the movie.
- **Saturday Princess Dessert Competition** – This is sure to be fun. We will be having a competition in the afternoon that only our **DAUGHTER's** will compete in. Dad's, that means you don't do anything, other than step back, watch and supervise (in case there are danger items, like knives or fire you can step in). The idea is that the princess is doing all the cooking or work to make the dessert. No prepared cakes or cookies can be brought in from home. Everything must be made from scratch on the grounds by the girls and the competition will be held at the Airnasium, so bring a table, pots, pans, stove or whatever you need to enter the competition. This will also be judged by Big Brave/Indian Princess combined teams (one from each tribe), but if you have an entry you cannot be selected as a judge. Here are the categories for the medals, plus all girls entering will get a special patch:
 - **Champion – Best Dessert**
 - **Messiest/Grossest Looking Dessert**
 - **Best Chocolate Dessert**
 - **Best Fruit Dessert**
 - **Best Cooked Dessert**
 - **Best Uncooked Dessert**
- **Tribe Time** - this is **NEW**. Unlike in many longhouses where there are constant go-go-go activities all day, in the afternoon there is a 1 1/2 hour block set aside for you to do something tribe oriented. Consider some project or something your tribe can do together, like make a piece of regalia or fix some regalia that was broken in the past. Basically, some quiet down time for you to work and be together as tribe.

Please bring firewood for the Sacred Fire (a duty of each tribe, at least two nice logs). Also, at opening & closing ceremony and the Sacred Fire, everyone should remember to wear their vests when possible and be respectful when someone has the Talking Stick. Dress accordingly and check the weather, because it can be up & down out there. Firewater and fireworks are prohibited.

Camping areas and cabins are selected by order of who finished with top coup points last year. If two tribes really feel like duking it out over something as silly as a patch of dirt, whoever had more coup points last year gets the area. We will attempt to have the cabins marked by tribe before everyone gets there.
